This graduate-level position will assist with assessing current and newly proposed open and closed Points of Distribution (POD)/Mass Vaccination Sites (MVS). The Fellow will assist with establishing new or updated agreements with community partners needed. In addition, this position will assist the XXXX County Public Health Emergency Preparedness Coordinator with completing grant deliverables. This Fellow will assist with updating and completing site-specific plans for POD/MVS based on best practices and lessons learned from the COVID-19 Pandemic and guidance provided by NYSDOH. This position will also plan for and conduct a community engagement activity to solicit public input on planned health emergency preparedness strategies; and perform community emergency preparedness educational sessions throughout the county.
