

THE 10 ESSENTIAL PUBLIC HEALTH SERVICES

To protect and promote the health of all people in all communities

The 10 Essential Public Health Services provide a framework for public health to protect and promote the health of all people in all communities. To achieve optimal health for all, the Essential Public Health Services actively promotepolicies, systems, and services that enable good. health and seek to remove. obstacles and systemic and structural barriers, such as poverty, racism, gender discrimination, and other forms of oppression, that have resulted in health inequities. Everyone should have a fair and just opportunity to achieve good health and well-being.





Resume Building

- Resume building is based on skills as much as it is job titles
 - What can you do to gain experience
 - What have you done that you can relate to the field
- Think about jobs you have held
- Think about volunteer positions you have had
- Think about roles in team projects
- Keep notes as you go about successes



Automated Screening for Resumes (ATS)

- Software many larger employers use when receiving resumes through emails, online portals, or other digital media
- Categorizes resume into sections (i.e. work experience, skills, education)
- Software looks for specific key words for job you are applying for and company



Constructing a Digital Resume

- Make sure you use key words!!! Study the job Posting and research the company
- Integrate key words throughout resume, do not lump them together
- Save your resume in a text format to submit... some ATS software have trouble reading a pdf
- Limit Unique Formatting
- Use a standard template
- Avoid putting too much in a header or footer
- Avoid a lot of Jargon or Acronyms
