

Post COVID-19 Opioid Overdose Deaths in Erie County, NY

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

Background

- Over 2,000 Erie County resident deaths from opioid-related overdose (2012-2022).
- In 2022, high peak of 307 opioid-related deaths in Erie county.

OBJECTIVES

- Identify the trends and characteristic of opioid overdose deaths in Erie County, NY.
- Create data driven response to the opioid epidemic in post COVID-19




METHODS

- Information was pulled from 2022 Opioid Epidemic Task Force quarterly meetings.
- Data was extracted from Erie County Medical Examiner's Office, Law Enforcement and treatment partners' collected data.
- Data visualization & Data analysis → Excel.


RESULTS


- 68% Whites, 28% Blacks, 2% Native Americans, and 12% Hispanics died from opioid fatal overdose.
- 15%, 30%, 24%, 22% and 10% of opioid overdose deaths from the age groups 20-29, 30-39, 40-49, 50-59 and 60+.











2022 AND 2023* PERCENT OF ERIE COUNTY OPIOID RELATED DEATHS

78% of persons who die from an opioid overdose die at or near their place of residence.



CONCLUSIONS

- Opioid-related overdose deaths: Young Adults
 →Adults & Elderly
- White Deaths \downarrow (79% in 2018 \rightarrow 68% in 2022)
- Black Deaths \uparrow (10% in 2018 \rightarrow 28% in 2022)
- Native American Deaths ↑ (0% in 2018 → 2% in 2022)
- Over half of the deaths have been associated with both fentanyl and cocaine.
- 3 out of 4 people (2022) died at or near their residence.



2016 - 2022* PERCENT OF ERIE COUNTY OPIOID RELATED DEATHS

2016 2017 2018 2019 2020 2021 2022 2023

2020: 485 [118/246] of oploid related deaths involved cocaine

2021: 44% [125/286] of oploid related deaths involved cocaine

2022: 57% [174/307] of oploid related deaths involved cocaine

2023: 48% [109/135] of oploid related deaths involved cocaine

*includes all Fentary related deaths.

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• 174 out of the 307 (57%) opioid overdose deaths that involved fentanyl and cocaine.

Public Health Implications

- Communicates within membership of Opioid Epidemic Task Force to promote collaboration and support partner work.
- Relays message to the public and government officials to acknowledge and to address the problem.
- Stigma among the public overlooks certain part of population in the community.
