### **NYSDOH - Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) Reports**

The Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS) is an annual telephone survey of adults developed by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention conducted in all 50 States, the District of Columbia, and several US Territories. The New York BRFSS is administered by the New York State Department of Health to provide statewide and regional information on behaviors, risk factors, and use of preventive health services related to the leading causes of chronic and infectious diseases, disability, injury, and death. Data from the BRFSS are useful for planning, initiating, and supporting health promotion and disease prevention programs at the state and federal level, and monitoring progress toward achieving health objectives for the state and the nation.

**NEW!** October 29, 2025, Number 2025-24: In recognition of World Stroke Day, the New York State Department of Health is pleased to announce the release of a new report based on 2023 data from the Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS), an annual statewide telephone survey of adults developed by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and administered by the New York State Department of Health.

The brief report, “[Cardiovascular Disease, New York State Adults, 2023](#)”, provides updated prevalence estimates of New York State adults who reported having had a heart attack, angina/coronary heart disease, or stroke in the state. According to the report:

- An estimated 1,251,000 adults (7.9%) in New York State report they have cardiovascular disease, meaning they report having had a heart attack, angina/coronary heart disease, or stroke. The proportion of adults reporting a heart attack, angina/coronary heart disease or stroke increases for each decade of life and is significantly higher for: men (9.5%); adults in households with annual income less than \$50,000 (11.1%); adults with Medicare coverage (18.5%); and adults aged 65 and older (18.6%).
- Cardiovascular disease prevalence is significantly higher among adults diagnosed with a depressive disorder (10.8%) and adults with a lack of reliable transportation (14.2%).
- The prevalence of cardiovascular disease in New York State is over three times greater among adults diagnosed with high blood pressure (15.9%), adults living with disability (16.1%), adults who report having fair or poor health (19.3%), and adults diagnosed with diabetes (20.9%) than among adults without those health conditions.

Cardiovascular disease is the leading cause of death in New York State, accounting for 31 percent of all deaths statewide. Heart disease and stroke are major causes of disability. Lifestyle modifications and interventions could prevent [as much as 80%](#) of heart disease and stroke<sup>3-7</sup>; these include [never starting to smoke or quitting](#), reducing [weight](#) to a normal level, being [physically active](#), [eating well](#), including consuming less [sugar-sweetened beverages](#) and reducing [excessive alcohol consumption](#), and being checked and treated for [high blood pressure \(HBP\)](#), [elevated cholesterol](#) and [diabetes](#).

**NEW!** October 23, 2025, Number 2025-21: The New York State Department of Health is pleased to announce the release of a [new report](#) based on data from the 2023 Behavioral Risk Factor Surveillance System (BRFSS). The report, “Breast Cancer Screening, New York State Adult Females aged 50-74, 2023”, presents data on breast cancer screening rates among eligible females overall and by region, demographics, and other risk factors and health behaviors. This report is intended to highlight progress while also noting disparities.

Key findings from the report include:

- An estimated 81.9% of New York State females aged 50-74 years were up to date with breast cancer screening recommendations, surpassing the nationwide Healthy People 2030 goal of 80.3% for the first time since 2020.
- Breast cancer screening prevalence has increased among eligible New York State females since 2021, following healthcare disruptions due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

- Females who were not up to date with colorectal cancer screening more often reported they were never or rarely screened for breast cancer (28.3%) compared with other females (6.0%). This may indicate common structural and personal barriers in accessing cancer screenings and preventive care.
- Among New York State females not up to date with breast cancer screening recommendations, almost all were insured (96.9%) and had a regular healthcare provider (95.1%), representing missed opportunities for screening.

The NYS Department of Health is committed to removing barriers to breast cancer screening through its partnership with the [NYS Cancer Consortium](#), supporting implementation of evidence-based interventions to increase cancer screenings in health center settings, and by providing screening for people without health insurance through the [Cancer Services Program](#).

**NEW!** October 30, 2025 - The New York State Department of Health is pleased to announce the release of a new report about walking and biking for transportation, based on data from the 2025 New York State Chronic Disease Public Opinion Poll.

Data from the report, “[Many New Yorkers Do Not Have Safe Places to Walk or Bike for Transportation](#),” show that 1 in 3 (31%) New Yorkers disagree that there are places to safely walk or bicycle from their home to places such as stores, restaurants, and other businesses. Nearly half of adults living in Upstate NY, outside NYC or its suburbs, disagree they have safe places to walk or bike near their homes.

Public Health Opportunity:

- To increase the prevalence of walking and biking in New York State, the Prevention Agenda 2025 - 2030 focuses on the social determinants of health, including “Neighborhood and Built Environment” strategies to increase opportunities for active transportation and physical activity.
- Local and regional public health, planning, transportation, and business partners can work with decision-makers, municipalities, and community coalitions to develop and implement Complete Streets policies, plans, and projects that create or enhance pedestrian infrastructure for safe and accessible walkable and bikeable communities.
- County-level estimates of physical activity can be used to identify priority areas, inform program planning, and evaluate the effectiveness of programs and policies.
- Public health organizations and programs can also use this information to educate local decisionmakers and increase community engagement with people of diverse lived experiences who may be impacted by potential neighborhood and built environment changes in their communities.
