## About Cornell Public Health Fellowships

Cornell Public Health Fellowships were established to prepare the next generation of public health leaders to tackle the wicked problems of our time, and rebuild our public health systems and capacity. **Cornell Public Health Fellows will receive full tuition support** toward Cornell University's two-year Master of Public Health degree, or our 12-month accelerated program, if eligible. *The Accelerated Program requires an advanced degree or relevant experience.*

Fellows will learn from interdisciplinary faculty, building skills using applied and community-engaged learning opportunities in which students translate theory into practice. Core training will prepare students to work in diverse settings across government, the private sector, public health and healthcare systems, and non-governmental organizations. Students will also receive specialized training in one of our four concentration areas: [Food Systems & Health](#), [Environment, Climate & Health](#), [Infectious Disease Epidemiology](#), or [Emergency Preparedness & Management](#).

## Application Timeline

- Apply to Cornell's MPH Program via [SOPHAS](#) by **March 23** for priority consideration
- Submit the [Cornell Graduate School Quick Application](#) by **March 23**
- Applicants will be notified of acceptance into the MPH Program and whether they will receive a Cornell Public Health Fellowship by **March 31st**
- Selected fellows must accept MPH admission and Cornell Public Health Fellowship offers by **April 15th**

## Eligibility Criteria

- [Apply](#) and be accepted to the [Cornell MPH Program](#)
- Be a U.S. citizen, U.S. national, or legal permanent resident of the U.S.
- Have a minimum GPA of 3.5 at the time of application
- Show your *passion* for an impactful career in public health through your program application materials
